Tony Bennett, P.Eng., FEIC Principal, T&L Consulting Canadian Dam Association (CDA)

Tony Bennett, recently retired from the position of Director of Dam and Public Safety for Ontario Power Generation, responsible for the Dam Safety Program covering dam safety, emergency management and public safety around dams, for a portfolio of 66 hydropower stations and 239 dams. During this time, he was involved in numerous dam safety reviews, failure modes analysis, safety emergency exercises, assessments and investigations.

He is Chair of the ICOLD Committee on Public Safety and Emergency Management, and CDA Working Groups on Emergency Management and Public Safety and a member of the CDA's Dam Safety Committee. He is past President of CDA and the Engineering Institute of Canada. He has served on the Province of Ontario's Advisory Panel on Dam Safety, and the CEATI Dam Safety Interest Group amongst other technical organizations.

Margaret Trias is a senior consultant with over 25 years of experience in the dams and hydropower, renewables and mining sectors having worked for large Canadian consulting engineering firms in the fields of hydrotechnical engineering, dam safety, emergency management, environmental and social impact assessment and management on projects around the world for many years. She is now an independent consultant and is an accredited lead assessor of the Hydropower Sustainability Standard.

She serves as the coordinator of the Canadian Dam Association's (CDA) International committee and is the Secretary of the ICOLD Committees of the Americas (INCA). Margaret is active on CDA's Finance Committee and Emergency Management Working Group and is the Canadian member of ICOLD Technical Committee G (Environment), as well as a member of the ICOLD Technical Committee ZX5 on Dams & Sustainability.

Dam Safety

- prevent an uncontrolled release of water (i.e. dam breach)
- have Emergency Preparedness Plans in place in the event of failure

Public Safety Around Dams

- safe management of water during normal operations intake water discharge from turbines
- security of the site to minimize the xposure of the public to hazards
